This day long workshop will provide an introduction to 'Positive Behaviour Support.' The focus will be on how to put the principles of positive behaviour support into practice. Participants will be given the opportunity to work through the principles of positive behaviour support in reference to the challenging behaviour of an individual who they are currently working with. This will give the participants a sense of how this approach can be applied in order to understand why people behave in ways that are challenging and begin to formulate strategies for dealing with these behaviours.
