

Disability & Society: Challenges in the 21st Century

This succinct monograph, authored by Professor Roy I. Brown, formerly Foundation Professor and Dean of the School of Special Education and Disability Studies at Flinders University in South Australia, consists of two chapters. The first chapter contains the 2001 Hilary Johnson lecture resented prior to Professor Brown's departure from the Adelaide academic scene. It describes current and future challenges faced by people with disabilities and their families, setting the scene for change in the current difficult climate of economic rationalism. The second chapter encapsulates highlights from the 'Options Report' an evaluation of 'Options Coordination', a service model initiated by the South Australian government involving five disability agencies working together to provide case management, service brokerage and service provision to people with disabilities.
